Summary/Position Overview:

The Golf Course Maintenance position is the daily role of keeping the golf course in pristine condition. Duties include, but are not limited to: mowing, trimming, blowing, edging, weed eating, raking, and watering.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Maintain all aspects of Golf Course property grounds as directed by superintendent.
- Use of hand equipment such as rakes, shovels, weed eaters, edgers, backpack blowers, mowers, trimmers, and more.
- Learn how to properly operate the equipment to perform tasks such as:
 - Mow fairways
 - Mow rough
 - Mow tees collars and approaches
 - Operate tractors
 - Blow clippings and debris
- Spread pine straw and mulch
- Promote a positive relationship with team members in all departments and divisions
